Total Project Cost: \$41M | Energy Improvements: \$10M



The Residences at the Greens

New Construction: Multi-Family

The Residences at the Greens is a 124-unit luxury 55+ independent senior living facility new construction project located in Jackson Township, OH. The project is part of a larger mixed-use redevelopment project of the former Tam O'Shanter Golf Course.

Total Project Cost: \$57M | Energy Improvements: \$6M
